

Information about Internships with LVS

Langford Veterinary Services offers six, 12-month rotating Internships in Small Animal Medicine and Surgery each year. Applicants must hold a veterinary degree registerable with the Royal College of Veterinary Surgeons. Please go to www.rcvs.org.uk if you are not certain whether your degree qualifies.

The UK Border Agency requires that applicants from the UK and the rest of the EU are given preference: applicants from Australia, New Zealand, South Africa, Canada and the USA must be eligible to obtain a visa.

Interns are registered as Junior Clinical Training Scholars with the University of Bristol. They are paid a tax-free stipend (currently 15,688 GBP) and receive 20 days vacation.

The intern year officially runs from July 1 to June 30th, but with an overlap period at the end of June.
