## OUTPATIENT REFERRAL SERVICE CLIENT INFORMATION SHEET

### COLONOSCOPY

- Please ensure that your pet is starved of food (to include all titbits) from 6pm the day prior to your appointment
- Do not restrict access to water until 2 hrs prior to your appointment time
- Please ensure that your pet has urinated and defecated prior to consultation
- Your pet will be admitted for its procedure by one of our clinicians or nurses
- Please note that LVS will only carry out procedures as requested by your veterinary surgeon
- LVS will report the findings of your pet's procedure directly to your veterinary surgeon
- LVS will invoice your veterinary practice for the procedure
- Your pet will be admitted to the hospital for 1 – 2 days for the procedure

NB. Your pet has to have a clean gastric tract to enable veterinary surgeons to properly visualise their intestines, this may mean that they will have to be hospitalised for up to 2 days to enable us to give them a solution (called Klean Prep) that will flush out all ingested and faecal matter.
